REQUEST

Dear: Resident/Family/POA

I would like to make everyone aware of Jamie, the home's maintenance support person. Most of Jamie's time is spent looking after all of the many building needs and following up with support services for the home's systems. It is not uncommon for resident's/family/POA to ask Jamie to provide personal services ranging from adjusting the time on a clock radio to installing a shelf or T.V., etc. The home provides time for the resident's admission for basic support in these items, however once admitted Jamie does not have time to provide personal services for residents as his main duties require his time to look after the building and related regulated requirements. If Jamie is asked to provide maintenance for personal reasons his time will be billed at the rate of \$28.00/hr. at half hour increments. This will include his time to document what was done on behalf of the resident/family/POA.
